demonstrates that the school food we provide in school is ethical, sustainable and fresh, free from nasty additives and transfats and meets school food standards. The award guarantees that food meets high standards of provenance and traceability.



This leaflet contains details of the menu at Carrwood after the Easter holiday.

Tasty, nutritious school meals have been provided in the Bradford district for many years.

The Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme means these meals are provided FREE to all primary school children in reception class and Years 1 & 2.

There are no forms to fill in, or other eligibility criteria. So if your child is in one of these year groups, you can simply send them along to school to enjoy a delicious free lunch each day. If you would be eligible for free school meals (see criteria overleaf), it's a good idea to still register as your school will benefit from extra funding.

Please Note: For children in Years 3-6. meals will be priced at £1.70, which is still great value for money.

- All fresh vegetables and potatoes are locally sourced, wherever possible.
- All our fish, vegetarian, and cheese dishes are suitable for Muslims.
- All desserts are suitable for vegetarians and Muslims.
- We do not use preservatives or additives that are unsuitable for children.
- We have a no nut and no genetically modified ingredient policy.
- The school meals provider at Carrwood have been awarded the bronze standard.

- Income Support Universal Credit
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, if not receiving Working Tax Credit
 Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 Income-related Employment and
- Working Tax Credit run-on

- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit only)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
