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Dear Parents/Carers,

With the children leaving for the residential tomorrow, I thought it would be a good idea to re-share the key points for the trip:

- Send your child to their high school transition day as normal. We will collect the children attending the residential. We aim to leave Carrwood by 1.30pm so please arrive at Carrwood to drop off their luggage and wave them off at 1.00pm.
- If your child has not brought their luggage in today, please ensure you arrive at school at 1.00pm to give it to them. This will also give you an opportunity to collect any mobile phones that they may have needed for their transition day as electronic items are not permitted.
- Your child must bring a sleeping bag/duvet and a pillow. A sleeping bag is preferable due to size. These are not provided by the residential centre.
- Your child can wear the same clothes they wear to their transition day to travel in. There will be an opportunity to change when they get there.
- Please ensure your child's luggage is in a bag no larger than a 10kg suitcase (no excessively large bags please) as we will have limited space.
- Ensure you have checked the kit list and included some bin bags for wet clothes. It is also a good idea to label all items to ensure all items are reunited with your child.
- All medication, including travel sickness tablets, needs to be given to a member of staff and a form needs to be completed.
- We aim to arrive back in school for around 4pm on Friday 3rd July but we will keep you updated via text message.

Example Residential Kit List:

Please note this list is an idea and not exhaustive and will change with the season:

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Refillable water bottle, named
- T-Shirts
- Fleece/Jumper
- Tracksuit Bottoms / Trousers (No jeans)
- Training Shoes / Trainers (No wellies, flip flops or sliders)
- Hat & Gloves
- Warm coat
- Waterproof Top & Trousers
- Sun Cream & Sun Hat
- Towel and wash kit (hair ties if needed)
- Touch and spare batteries
- Clothes and shoes to go on/in the water that can get wet
- Tuck shop money if requested by the school
- Named luggage bag and bedding bag

We would suggest everything is named and parents usually pack and the students can get confused on arrival.

No electronic devices or valuables

Medication is to be named and given to school staff not centre staff.
